## 1. The decision:

- 1.1. That the Leader and Executive Member for Hampshire 2050 and Corporate Services approves:
  - a) Two grants totalling £18,900 from the Leader's Community Grant Fund 2023/24 to cultural and community organisations in Hampshire, as set out in Appendix 1.
  - b) One grant totalling £5,278 from the Parish and Town Council Investment Fund, as set out in Appendix 2.
  - c) One grant totalling £5,000 from the Rural Community Fund, as set out in Appendix 3.

## 2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. Two organisations have applied for a grant through the Leader's Community Grant Fund totalling £40,176, one organisation has applied for a grant from the Parish Town Council Investment Fund (PTCIF) totalling £5,278 and one organisation has applied for a grant from the Rural Community Fund (RCF) totalling £5,000, for 2023/24.
