

**The Commons Act 2006 - Schedule 2 Paragraph 6  
Application to deregister land within the curtilage of a building,  
wrongly registered as common land**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by Mr John and Mrs Helen Fleming of Folly Cottage, North Warnborough Green, Hampshire, RG29 1HF, to Hampshire County Council as Commons Registration Authority, in respect of land falling within the curtilage of their property (as shown outlined in red on the accompanying plan and described more fully below).

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows:

The land was provisionally registered as common land on 21 February 1968, under Section 4 Commons Registration Act 1965, and forming part of Warnborough Green (CL108). The provisional registration became final on 1 October 1970. It is asserted that, at the time of provisional registration, the land was covered by a building, or fell within the curtilage of a building, and that this position remains unchanged.

The application seeks to remove from the Commons Register that parcel of land shown on the accompanying plan. If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by removing part of the land from the register of common land.
