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1. The decision:

 a) That the Executive Member for Adult Social Care and Health gives approval to spend up to £735 million for contracts awarded under the Help to Live at Home Open Framework to commence August 2017 for a period of up to 7 years on a 5 + 2 basis.

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. To contract with providers to deliver care and support services in Hampshire for older people, people with a physical disabilities and mental health needs.
- 2.2. The proposed seven year framework takes account of the need to promote stability in the market and to support stable provision for individual service users, as well as investment by providers in staff, training and new technologies.
- 2.3. The new Framework will be more dynamic and flexible than the existing arrangement allowing suppliers and new entrants to the market to be accepted onto the Framework at any time during the 5 + 2 year duration.
- 2.4. Current Care at Home and REACT contracts are due to expire in 2018, the Help to Live at Home open framework will replace these contractual arrangements following a EU compliant OJEA tender exercise.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1. To extend the current contractual arrangements. This was considered and rejected as the care model needs to change in order to reflect the County Council's Care Offer.
- 3.2. To bring all services in house. This was considered and rejected as this was not a viable option county wide and would not meet the necessary timescales for implementation.
