Following extensive scoping work and initial stakeholder engagement, Hampshire County Council is now in a position to consult on its proposed fourth Local Transport Plan (LTP4).

The new Transport Plan will replace the existing LTP3 and provide a framework to guide all our future transport planning and investment.

A new plan is required in order to:

take account of new / changing policies and priorities, particularly around climate change, health and equality, including Hampshire's 2050 Vision and Climate Emergency declaration;

provide guidance on transport issues to our stakeholders;

respond to the financial challenges which we are facing as a Council;

respond to the opportunities and risks presented by COVID-19; and

enable Hampshire to secure the maximum funding available from the Government.

The draft LTP4 document outlines the proposed vision, guiding principles, policies and implementation plan that the County Council believes are required to deliver a set of core outcomes within the next 30 years.

This consultation seeks your views on the proposed approach, the impacts that may arise as a result and any alternative options that should also be included.
