## 1. The decision:

- 1.1. This is an application, made by a member of the public in 2007, under Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The application seeks to record a public footpath over St Catherine's Hill, running between Garnier Road and Five Bridges Road, Winchester.
- 1.2. It is considered that the documentary and user evidence reviewed is insufficient for it to be inferred that, on the balance of probabilities, the public has acquired a right of way on the claimed route, and it recommended that the application be refused.

## 2. Reason(s) for the decision:

2.1. Hampshire County Council has a duty to determine applications made under Section 53(5) Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. An analysis of documentary and user evidence (set out in the accompanying background report) indicates that, on the balance of probability, the public has not acquired a right of way over the claimed route.
