Title:	Proposed Traffic Order: Swanwick Lane - No waiting at anytime
Reference:	A1012

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1. The decision:

1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be to introduce no waiting at any time near the new Bellway development on Swanwick lane, as follows:

- (i) North-west side, between its junction with Bridge Road and its junction with access road leading to the Bellway Development, an approximate distance of 68 metres.
- (ii) North-west side, between its junction with the access road leading to the Bellway Development and a point approximately 36 metres north-east thereof.
- (iii) South-east side, between its junction with Bridge Road and a point approximately 109 metres north-east thereof.

2. Reasons for the decision:

2.1. As a condition of planning permission being granted for the Bellway Development on Swanwick Lane, a developer contribution has been secured towards the implementation of new waiting restrictions in the area. It is, therefore, intended that new double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) be implemented on Swanwick Lane in the vicinity of the new access. The proposed restrictions are intended to aid safe movement of vehicles and to prevent obstructive parking.

2.2 No objections were received in response to the public consultation which took place between 3rd November 2017 and 24th November 2017 – notices were placed on site, the public notice in The Independent appeared on 3rd November 2017 and copies of the notice, draft order, statement of reason, existing orders and drawings of the site are on display at The Lockwood Centre, Fareham Borough Council and Hampshire County Council offices, where they will remain

until six weeks after the order is sealed if the scheme goes ahead. These documents also appeared on the public notices website for the public consultation period.
