
# Fly-Tipping Update

#### **Joint Operations**

3 Joint Operations planned in partnership with LA, HC, HMRC, EA, TS, DVSA and HCC

- 17<sup>th</sup> April in the New Forest (A337).
- 179 vehicles were stopped.
- EA issued advice to 5 traders carrying waste.
- Several vehicles/drivers were issued with various levels of fines.
- 1 vehicle seized
- 1 person arrested.
- 10<sup>th</sup> May in Yateley (A30).
- 55 vehicles stopped
- No EA advice given
- No arrests
- Several vehicles/drivers were issued with various levels of fines.
- 7<sup>th</sup> June location tbc



### Police Rural Crime Partnership

- Opportunity to raise the profile of the HFTS. Promote the HCC FT webpage to private landowners and national bodies (NFU/CLA).
- This has allowed close partnership working with the Hampshire Police Countrywatch Team.
- Access to joint resources for operations.
- Mark Gammon of the C.P.S who has provided two pro-forma statement templates allowing partnership case files to better highlight the costs and environmental impact of Fly-Tipping.

- TOR's agreed.
- BDBC dedicated FT officer.
- Parish council representative will feedback to and engage with HALC.
- Intelligence protocols agreed.
- Standardised case file presentation agreed.
- Hopefully Hampshire will be able to follow the recent success of other counties Two recent Fly-Tippers imprisoned. One in Kent and one in Hertfordshire.



### In Progress

- EA delivered training to 18 TS officers 8<sup>th</sup> May. And is being evaluated before a
  possible roll out to partners.
- Comms work progressing well with a next steps meeting today.
- Recent conference call with DEFRA regarding HFTS has resulted in an invite to NFTPG meeting
- EFRA report on reviewing magistrates sentencing and streamlining prosecutions in line with work we have already planned.
- Building a better working relationship with Parish councils around intelligence sharing and the reporting of fly-tipping.
