QUESTIONS SUBMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDING ORDER 16.1.1

1. From Councillor Alan Dowden to the Executive Member for Recreation and Heritage:

“Would the Executive Member inform the Council how much money would be saved by the proposal of withdrawing financial support to the North Baddesley Community Library?”

2. From Councillor Ray Bolton to the Executive Member for Recreation and Heritage:

"Given that the Library Services Public Consultation is currently in progress, please would the Executive Member confirm that no decisions have been taken in relation to Libraries and that there are many options for consideration as to their future operation?"

3. From Councillor Fran Carpenter to the Executive Member for Adult Social Care and Health:

“I have two new residential schemes within my county area of New Milton North - Fernhill Court Assisted Living homes for younger adults with learning disabilities, now completed with residents moving in - and, as yet unnamed, a new development of Extra Care homes for older people, currently still being built. Would the Executive Member provide me with a brief progress report on these two local schemes?”

4. From Councillor Pal Hayre to the Executive Lead Member for Children’s Services and Young People:

"I understand that Hampshire County Council has recently accepted an invitation from the Department of Education to support a programme of improvement for Children’s Services in West Sussex. Would the Executive Member explain the implications of this for Hampshire County Council Children ‘s Services?"

5. From Councillor Jackie Porter to the Executive Lead Member for Children’s Services and Young People:

"Why does the Council reduce the grants to youth services at the same time setting up new systems to reduce violent crime amongst young people?"

6. From Councillor Roger Huxstep to the Executive Member for Commercial Strategy, Human Resources and Performance:

“Will the Executive Member state the requisite annual revenue for just running the council's statutory services? And, what would be the average annual percentage increase in the revenue required to sustain those services over say the next five years, notwithstanding inflation, but taking into account increased demand for such services?"

7. From Councillor Jan Warwick to the Executive Member for Economy, Transport and Environment:

“Could the Executive Member expand on how HCC will take the lead on rolling out plans and activities towards the Climate Change greening campaign across communities and Districts throughout Hampshire?”

8. From Councillor Steve Forster to the Executive Member for Economy, Transport and Environment:

“Could the Executive Member update members on the impact this very wet autumn and winter has had on the highway network and what measures he’s taking in response?”
