2) Consultations:

Following the publication of the Regulatory Committee Report on 03 January 2023 further consultation responses and representations have been received. These include:

Update to paragraph 62 (change highlighted in *italic*) as follows:

Winchester City Council - Planning: Objection due to noise and the detrimental impact to the amenity of the nearby residential dwellings, in line with Policies DM17 and DM20 of the Winchester City Council Local Plan Part 2 (2017). *No further comments to make.*

Update to paragraph 65 (change highlighted in *italic*) as follows:

South Wonston Parish Council: Objection on the grounds of highway safety. Despite the additional information submitted by the applicant in December 2022, the Parish Council supports the objections given by County Councillor Porter in terms of adverse impacts to local road safety, including on non-motorised users of the local road network and land adjoining it.

3) Representations:

Update to paragraph 71 (changes highlighted in *italic*):

As of 3 January 2023, a total of 262 264 representations to the proposal have been received. There were 8 representations in support of the proposal, predominately from customers and affiliates of the applicant, with the remainder all objecting to or raising concerns about the proposal, predominately from local residents and groups.

4) Updates to the commentary:

Update to paragraph 141 (changes highlighted in *italic*):

Whilst the update to the HMWP cannot be given any policy weight in decision making (as it is emerging and only at a very early stage in the process), the proposal is *net* considered to meet the main provisions of emerging Policy 13 (Managing traffic).
