As we are all aware, adult social care is one of the biggest responsibilities which we have as a Council. The current model, whereby we pay for assessed need as a contribution to private providers is coming under severe strain with inflationary pressures. A constituent of mine almost had to move back to live with her parents due to their inability to pay the shortfall. I'm pleased to say that was resolved, but how do we ensure that every scarce penny of public money is being used as efficiently as possible to provide care for our residents, and how can we address the growing problem of those who need care having to fund sometimes unaffordable shortfalls with commercial care providers?
