- 3.52. 06 Sep. Routine patrol and mooring checks. Support to Marine Police Unit exercise.
- 3.53. 07 Sep. Routine patrol and mooring checks. Placed notice on unmarked tender on the Harbour Master's jetty at Warsash. Upgraded workshop first aid kit. Signage replacement work. Assistance given to a small motor boat with a failed bilge pump.
- 3.54. 08 Sep. Routine patrol and mooring checks. Work to establish ownership of two unidentified tenders on Warsash Jetty. Patrol rendered assistance to a yacht aground on Hamble spit on a falling tide. Crew walked ashore to Hamble Point to await refloat on the next High Water.
- 3.55. 09 Sep. Routine patrol and mooring checks. Patrol pumped out tenders on the Warsash Harbour Master's Jetty. Patrol rendered assistance to a yacht with a mooring line caught around her propellor.
- 3.56. 10 Sep. Routine patrol and mooring checks. Re-secured a yacht with a loose bow line. Pumped out a small fishing boat. Secured loose foresail on a moored yacht. Re-positioned fenders on a yacht moored on the midstream Visitors' Pontoon.
- 3.57. 11 Sep. Routine patrol and mooring checks. Patrol baled out a moored dory awash in strong winds. Liaison with HM Coast Guard regarding a new motor boat bound for Southampton Boat Show which had caught fire. Fire Brigade called to Warsash but vessel diverted to Southampton.
- 3.58. 12 Sep. Routine patrol and mooring checks. Liaison with Southampton HM Patrol to re-attach a notice on Hamble Point Southerly Cardinal buoy. Gave assistance to a jet ski coxswain, broken down on the midstream Visitors' Pontoon. Towed to Warsash for recovery.
- 3.59. 13 Sep. Routine patrol and mooring checks. Patrol returned several yachts to their proper moorings for the Crown Estate following completion of planned maintenance work. Patrol moved boats on the midstream Visitors' Pontoon in preparation for a weekend rally. Secured loose headsail on a moored yacht. Monitoring of bait digging adjacent to Warsash Sailing Club slipway. Both bait diggers advised of Bye Laws and given copy of the bait digging code of practice.
