1. The decision:

- 1.1 That the Executive Member for Policy and Resources approves the proposed changes to the legal agreement for Transport for South Hampshire and the Isle of Wight (also known as Solent Transport), as set out in Appendix A of the report, and gives authority to enter into contractual arrangements in consultation with the Head of Legal Services.
- 1.2 That the Executive Member for Policy and Resources confirms that Solent Transport shall from this point onwards report to the Executive Member for Economy Transport and Environment on operational, policy and budgetary matters.

2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1 The Solent Transport Joint Committee has agreed that changes and updates are required to the Transport for South Hampshire and Isle of Wight (TfSHIOW) legal agreement to assist with the smooth running of the Joint Committee.
- 2.2 Solent Transport is an organisation that for operational, policy and budgetary purposes falls within the decision-making responsibilities of the Executive Member for Economy Transport and Environment. It is therefore appropriate, for the purposes of continuity and efficiency that authority for these matters is confirmed as being with the Executive member for Economy Transport and Environment, as the most appropriate level of decision making by the County Council. Authority was originally transferred from the Environment and Transport portfolio to that of Policy and Resources to avoid a conflict of interest at a time when the Executive Member for Environment and Transport was also Chairman of Solent Transport. This is no longer the case.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

3.1 Not to agree the changes to the Solent Transport Joint Committee. This option was rejected as it would effectively amount to leaving the organisation.

3.2 The option to continue with the current portfolio arrangements has been considered but rejected as it is an inefficient and ineffective use of resource and does not provide for transparent accountability by the County Council decision-making processes.

- 1.1. That the Executive Member for Policy and Resources is nominated as the proposed Board Member of the Solent Freeport Company Ltd.
- 1.2. That the County Council supports an 'in principle' agreement of providing a three-year revenue contribution to support the development of the Freeport, subject to the development of a robust and acceptable business plan and financial strategy for the Company and evidence of good progress in delivering a successful Freeport.
- 1.3. That the County Council agrees to make a contribution to the Solent Freeport Company Ltd of £50,000 for 2021/22 from the Investing in Hampshire Fund.

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. Hampshire County Council is designated as a Core (Voting) Member of the Solent Freeport Company Ltd given the strategic role the County Council has played and is continuing to play, in the design, development and delivery of a Freeport for Hampshire.
- 2.2. Solent Freeport Company Ltd is the overall new governance body charged with the design development and delivery of the Freeport for Hampshire. 'Eight English Freeports' is a flagship Government policy and the decision-making of this new Board is critical to the delivery of the Solent Freeport in Hampshire and therefore requires the highest level leadership and decision-making that extends oversight across the full range of Council functions, powers and resources, to maximise the benefits for the County and Hampshire as a whole.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1. Not to nominate a representative on the Freeport Board. This option was rejected on the basis that this would mean that the interests of the wider Hampshire area and the County Council would not be fully represented.
- 3.2. The Deputy Leader or another Cabinet Member could take on the role, and whilst this may provide an option in relation to substitution, it is felt the office

holder of the Leader of the Council is most appropriate given the corporate nature and wide-reaching significance of the Freeport status in Hampshire.

- 4.1. The decision proposed here involved the Executive Member nominating himself. It is nevertheless considered that as the decision is being taken in an open and transparent manner there is no conflict of interest.
