2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. The voluntary and community sector make an important contribution to early help support for families with multiple and complex needs. The grant recommendations ensure funding is distributed to a range of projects across Hampshire. The remaining £20,198 of the £200k grant fund, was allocated for grant values below £5k. A number of the projects supported focus on mental wellbeing and family relationships areas which have been particularly impacted upon by Covid-19 and the associated period of lockdown.
- 2.2. By supporting families in accordance with the principles of the Supporting Families Programme, the grant funding allocated will promote the priority areas within the Hampshire Children & Young People's Plan (CYPP).

3.1. The decision to include a grants round formed part of wider discussions relating to how the Supporting Families funding for 2020/21 and 2021/22 could be put to best use to enable families across Hampshire to access support at an early help level.
