At the junction of New Road and Footpath 20, looking north. The signs read "Please keep to the public footpath – Dogs must be kept on a lead" and "Please close gate behind you, livestock in field"



Gate X. Point B, looking north. Metal field gate bearing 'No public right of way' sign. The gap to the right of the gate has been blocked with rails and barbed wire. The gate is padlocked. During the site visit, the landowner and investigating officer went around the gate via the narrow gap on the left.



Point B, looking south along Footpath 20. The kissing gate shown on the left is the continuation of Footpath 20 around the field edge.



Gate Y. Gate located at the top of the track between the stables. Old concrete was noted under the adjacent rail fence and the landowner indicated that this had probably been put in place to enable people to use the route.



Gate Z. Near Point A, looking south along the claimed route. Sign reads "No public right of way". There are three strands of barbed wire across the gap between the post and rail fence.

- ** Logical termination point for claimed route. There appears to be a minor misalignment of Footpaths 19 and 23 at this point: the gate is located part way up the field, rather than in the corner.
