1. The decisions:

1.1. That the Leader and Executive Member for Hampshire 2050 and Corporate Services approves:

- a) Two grants totalling £30,000 from the Leader's Community Grant Fund 2023/24 to cultural and community organisations in Hampshire, as set out in Appendix 1 to the report;
- b) One grant totalling £13,144 from the Parish and Town Council Investment Fund, as set out in Appendix 2 to the report;
- c) Two grants totalling £12,500 from the Rural Community Fund, as set out in Appendix 3 to the report.

2. Reasons for the decisions:

2.1 Two organisations have applied for a grant through the Leader's Community Grant Fund totalling £40,100, one organisation has applied for a grant from the Parish Town Council Investment Fund (PTCIF) totalling £13,144 and two organisations have applied for a grant from the Rural Community Fund (RCF) totalling £18,162 for 2023/24.

2.2 The report considers the applications and recommends the awards totalling £30,000 from the Leader's Community Grant Fund, £13,144 from the Parish Town Council Investment Fund (PTCIF) and £12,500 from the Rural Community Fund (RCF). The recommended awards can be met from within existing budget provision.
