1.1. That the Executive Member for Adult Social Care and Health agrees to:

- i) Award Methodist Homes Association (MHA) a grant totalling £66,304 over a two year period between April 2018 and March 2020 as part of the Community Based Support Grant.
- ii) Award Brendoncare Clubs a grant totalling £49,696 over a two year period between April 2018 and March 2020 as part of the Community Based Support Grant.

## 2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1 The Voluntary and Community Sector (VCS) contributes to improving people's quality of life. The grants programme is one of the ways in which County Council supports the sector to support people to live fuller more independent lives and to reduce the demand for County Council services.
