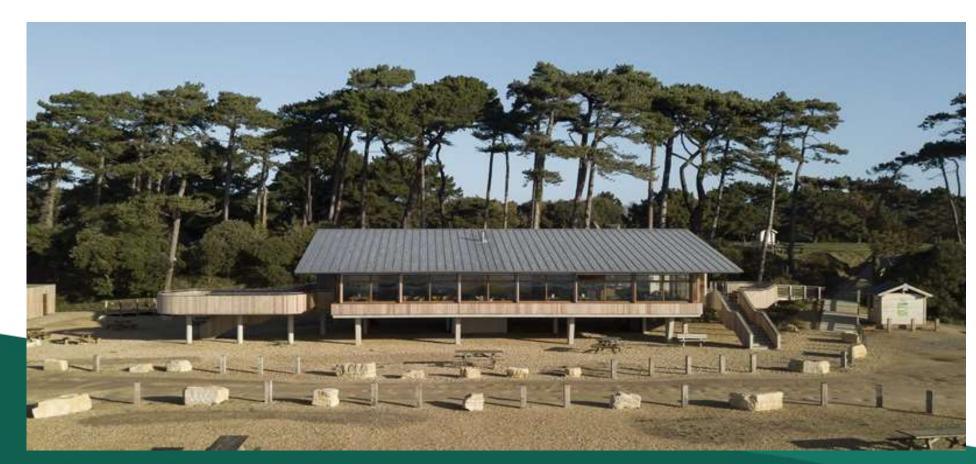


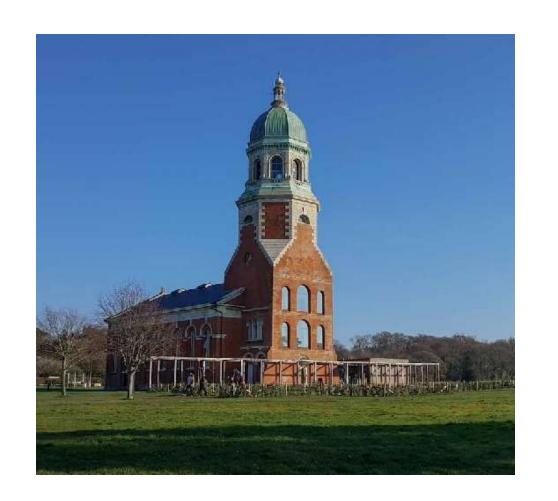






- The Lookout opened on 4 May 2018
