THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 ('the Regulations')

REGULATION 10 - KEY DECISIONS

Regulation 10 (general exception) allows for a key decision to be made if it is impracticable for notice of the intention to take a key decision under Regulation 9 to be given 28 clear days in advance of the taking of the decision. Regulation 10 sets out the actions required to be taken in those circumstances which include giving public notice at least five working days before the decision is taken.

The Executive Member for Adult Social Care and Health intends to take a key decision regarding approval to spend for the Help to Live at Home Open Framework, at a meeting on 21 June 2017 at 15:00 at: The Castle, Winchester.

The intention to take this decision was previously notified, and due to recent changes in Executive Member responsibilities, this is being re-notified to confirm that the decision maker will be the Executive Member for Adult Social Care and Health. It was impracticable to give the required 28 days notice of the Executive Member for Adult Social Care and Health's intention to take this key decision due to the timing of the recent portfolio changes.
