PUBLIC NOTICE

THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 ('the Regulations')

REGULATION 5 – PRIVATE MEETINGS

Regulation 5 (Procedures prior to private meetings) allows for a meeting to be held in private if it is impracticable for notice of the intention to do so to be given 28 clear days in advance of the meeting. Regulation 5 (paragraphs 6-7) sets out the actions required to be taken in those circumstances, which includes obtaining the agreement of the Chairman of the relevant Select Committee that the private meeting may be held.

The Cabinet intends to consider the following report containing exempt information within Paragraphs 3 and 5 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972, being information relating to the financial or business affairs of any particular person (including the authority holding the information) and information in respect of which a claim to legal professional privilege could be maintained in legal proceedings:

Blackbushe Airport: Progress of Judicial Review and associated potential costs

in private at a remote meeting on 15 May 2020 at 14:00.

It was impracticable to give the required 28 days notice of the Cabinet's intention to consider this item in private due to the rapidly evolving situation caused by the Covid-19 pandemic and the consequential requirement for a decision to be reached by Cabinet at the earliest opportunity.

In accordance with Regulation 5 (paragraph 6), agreement has been obtained from the Chairman of the (relevant) Policy and Resources Select Committee that the meeting is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.
