PUBLIC NOTICE

THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 ('the Regulations')

REGULATION 11 - KEY DECISIONS

Regulation 11 (special urgency) allows for a key decision to be made if it is impracticable for notice of the intention to take a key decision under Regulation 9 to be given 28 clear days in advance of the taking of the decision. This also allows for a Key Decision to be taken where it is impractical for public notice at least five working days before the decision is taken to be given in accordance with Regulation 10. Regulation 11 sets out the actions required to be taken in those circumstances which include gaining the consent of the Chairman of the relevant Select Committee or in their absence, of the Chairman of the County Council. A quarterly report of the Leader detailing Key Decisions taken under Regulation 11 is presented to the County Council.

The Director of Corporate Resources intends to take a key decision on:

Purchase of IT Equipment to Enable Better Home Working

on 4 June 2020.

It was impracticable to give the required 28 days notice of the Director's intention to take this Key Decision as immediate implementation of the proposed decision to purchase is necessary in order to secure the procurement option that has been negotiated.

In accordance with Regulation 11, agreement has been obtained from the Chairman of the County Council, that the Key Decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.
