## 1. The decision:

1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be to introduce virtual permits for designated permit parking places and replace the existing charges for permits in Fareham with the following:

Residents' Permit £50 per annum Residents' Carer Permit £50 per annum

Visitor Day Permit 100 visitor permits included free for

each residence

Business Visitor Permit (1hour) £50 per annum

## 2. Reason(s) for the decision:

2.1. As part of the Transformation to 2019 financial savings proposals, the County Council is modernising the on-street parking service across Hampshire.

From 1st April 2020 Hampshire County Council will be directly responsible for the parking services in Fareham, Gosport and Test Valley, where the Borough Councils no longer operate Traffic Management Agency Agreements. In order to achieve more consistency in the parking service between these Boroughs and bring them in line with the other Districts in Hampshire, the charges and processes for Resident Parking Schemes are being amended as follows -

- Phased increases in annual permit charges will be implemented with the intention of achieving a minimum charge of £50 by 2022/23
- A virtual permit system is being introduced.
