Title:	Grange Junior School – Contract Award with McAvoy

1. The decision:

- 1.1 Approval to allocate an additional £247,000 of the Schools Condition Allocation funding to the project replacing the existing building at Grange Junior School.
- 1.2 This approval increases the funding allocation from £7,924,000 to £8,171,000 for the project.

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1 The tender return for the works at Grange Junior was £1.36m over budget. The team have worked through a Value Engineering exercise which was reduced this by £920k, £220k of which is the omission of the temporary accommodation that may be required to meet a bulge in pupils which Children's Services have agreed that they will fund if required.
- 2.2 The project team have also reviewed the level of contingency and as the project is Design and Build project proposed that this is reduced to £150k (just over 2%) to cover any risk in the ground or with the demolition. This leaves a funding shortfall of £247k including fees.
- 2.4 The project at Fryern Junior School is on site and is currently predicted to be £340k under budget which would offset the additional ask at Grange Junior School.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

3.1 The additional costs are due to very poor ground conditions and additional prelims related to the site, which total £900k more than at Fryern School. The building cost for Grange and Fryern are comparable with net costs £2,680/m2 vs £2,798m2, so the team have concluded that we cannot reduce the costs further without significant scope change.
