### 1. The decision:

- 1.1. The Trustees of Four Marks Village Hall was awarded £9,000 towards the replacement of the flat roof on 19 September 2019, on condition that funding is also secured from East Hants District Council and that Safeguarding and Reserves Policies are developed and submitted.
- 1.2. The decision is to change the condition of grant to remove the requirement for funding also to be secured from East Hants District Council.

### 2. Reason(s) for the decision:

- 2.1. While the project has been delayed during the Covid-19 pandemic, the group has been able to increase its reserves to meet the remaining project costs.
- 2.2. Removing the condition will enable the project to proceed to the benefit of the local community, without unnecessarily drawing on further public funds.
- 2.3. On that basis, it makes sense to remove the condition for funding also to be secured from East Hants District Council.
