## 1. The decision:

- 1.1 That the Executive Member gives approval to the project proposals set out in this report at a total cost of £515,000.
- 1.2 That the Executive Member approve the property arrangements by which the operational responsibility for WDC is transferred to Hampshire Cultural Trust (HCT) (including the nature and duration of tenure).
- 1.3 That the Executive Member approves the proposals contained in the exempt Appendix.

## 2. Reason(s) for the decision:

2.1 This project will transfer operational responsibility for the WDC building (including associated day-to-day running costs) and for cultural programming to HCT. The Library Service will continue to deliver a highly successful library service, free at the point of access, within WDC.

- 2.2 Hampshire County Council and Hampshire Cultural Trust are developing a new partnership model which will enhance and develop Winchester Discovery Centre's position as a strategically important hub for culture and creativity in Hampshire. The overall strategy has been agreed by the Executive Member for Recreation, Heritage and Rural Affairs.
- 2.3 This report sets out proposals to refurbish elements of WDC, including essential maintenance work, interior refurbishment and spatial reorganisation to enable the future strategy to be realised.
- 2.4 The HCC element of the project is to be funded from the CCBS Capital Programme 2021/22 and was approved by the County Council in February 2021 at a value of £500,000 with a further £15,000 allocated from CCBS Cost of Change funding.
- 2.5 In addition to the refurbishment project, the proposals include the transfer of operational responsibility for the building (including associated day-to-day running costs) and for cultural programming to HCT. The Library Service will continue to deliver a highly successful library offer, free at the point of access, within WDC.
