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### 1. The decision:

1.1. That the Executive Member for Environment and Transport declares the land between Warsash Road, Schooners Way and Dibles Road in Warsash, as coloured red on the attached plan, ("the Land" and "the Plan") surplus to highway requirements.

### 2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1 The County Council holds two parcels of severed land, purchased in 2005, left over following the construction of the Fareham Western Wards, Western Distributor Phase 3, which has never been used for highway purposes and no highway rights exist.
- 2.2 The Land does not form part of the existing operational highway, is not needed for future highway purposes and no highway rights exist. From a highways and transport operational perspective it has been confirmed the Land is surplus to highway requirements.
