2. Reasons for the decision:

2.1. Protecting and enhancing the natural environment is of the highest importance to the County Council and a fundamental part of its commitment to tackling climate change in Hampshire. The purpose of this report is to set out the actions taken by the County Council to protect the natural environment, to describe its key current activities in this important area, to outline recent and forthcoming changes, including in national legislation, and to seek approval for the approach to address these new requirements.

The option of not seeking agreement of the proposed approach to meet the new requirements imposed by national legislation and other changes was rejected on the basis that this would not enable the County Council: to meet its obligations effectively; to capitalise on the unique opportunities afforded by the new circumstances to benefit the natural environment and address the challenge of climate change; or to demonstrate a position of leadership and desire to collaborate with partners working in this area at the local, regional and national level.
